



Homayra Sellier, is the founder and CEO of Innocence in Danger, a worldwide movement to protect minors against all forms of abuse & exploitation online and offline, including trafficking.

Nominated by the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization/ UNESCO in 1999 (following the bust and dismantling of what was then considered the biggest child exploitation network online), to carry out the action plan of the global campaign on «Sexual Abuse of Children, Child Pornography and Pedophilia on the Internet : «An International Challenge».

Since April 2000, Innocence in Danger is founded by Mrs. Sellier, as an independent «non-governmental organization» in France, followed by Germany, Austria, Switzerland, Colombia, and later in Portugal and Belgium.

Mrs. Sellier was awarded for her work in child trafficking in the US.

The organization's work has influenced a number of changes in the law, Mrs. Sellier is auditioned by legislators, ministers, and world leaders for her expertise in this field.

Amongst other achievements, in 2002, Mrs. Sellier initiated art and sports therapies for survivors of sexual abuse, the art therapy program was assessed and studied by German, French, Suisse, and South American experts and was confirmed to be resilient and therapeutic.

Innocence in Danger collaborates with scientists on bio-genetic brain research, in order to underline the lifetime impacts of brain alterations experienced by survivors of abuse and ill-treatment at an early age, the outcome of this study/research can result in breakthrough progress in preventive medicine as well as in the juridical world. The organization is currently working on prevention publications and programs to address the dangers of social networks for children and youth.

Bachelor from two French universities Homayra Sellier (graduated from «Université René-Descartes» in public relations and later CELSA an IVY university attached to the Sorbonne, in social and human relations. Fluent in French, English, Spanish, and Farsi.

Mrs Sellier has written five books and participated in a number of documentaries for International TV and is consulted by movie directors and producers on movies that highlight and raise child protection topics, some have been selected and nominated in major Film Festivals.

Mrs. Sellier is a primary judge at the TRIFF film festival (Tryon International Film Festival) - human rights section since its genesis seven years ago.

In 2020, Mrs. Sellier was invited to be a jury member of the Torino Film Festival in Italy.
